

## Une Bande Dessinée

Belgium is the comic book capital of the world! For your project on Belgium, you will be creating and presenting a comic strip, in French, in groups of 2-4 people of your choosing. Using page 49 of your text as a guide, you will be writing and illustrating your own comic strip on whatever topic you choose. Although you will start out with a rough draft of your comic strip on paper, your final comic will be presented through a Power Point presentation.

### Project Timeline:

- **Thursday 12/1-** Form groups, gather ideas, fill out group form, begin rough draft
  - **HW:** work on rough draft
- **Friday 12/2-** Work in class to continue rough draft
  - Rough draft to is due at the end of class Friday
- **Monday 12/5- Thursday 12/6:** ILL lab to work on Power Point
- **Friday 12/7: FINAL COMICS DUE - Presentations**

### Guidelines and Requirements:

- Your comic must be at least 11 frames long- including an opening/title frame with the title of your comic and your names.
- A completed rough draft on paper complete with spelling, grammar and sketches of images must be complete before you can begin working on Power Point
- Be creative but remember that you have to write this in French, so keep it simple!
- Have fun!

Your Power Point presentation with your comic strip should:

- Have at least 11 slides with 2-3 sentences per slide in correct French
  - Have at least 2 animations/ transitions
  - Have at least 7 images (scanned, clip art, from web, etc)
  - Have integrated sounds that are consistent and fit your comic
- The above requirements are all the minimum requirements to receive an A. However, if you lack in information, your grammar and spelling aren't great or you slack in other areas, an A is not guaranteed.
  - How you choose to organize the material is up to you but a very high priority will be placed on accuracy and completeness.
  - The use of colors, animation effects and other "bells and whistles" are a nice addition after you have done an excellent job on the basics. You cannot replace substantive information with cuteness.
